

## School Crossing Patrol - Grade 3

In line with recognised guidelines, you will stop vehicles in order for pedestrians to cross the road safely, maintaining control over pedestrians who are waiting for your instruction to cross and being observant at all times to road traffic activity.

### The Job

You will ensure the safety of pedestrians crossing the road at a designated patrol point within the Kirklees area between specified times in the morning and afternoon before and after school with minimal disruption to other road users.

You will report any incidents of dangerous driving and to deal quickly with any emergency situations in line with Council procedures reporting to the Senior Technical Officer.

You will be required to work in all weather conditions and wear the School Crossing Patrol uniform provided.
